A Word From: Pastor Troy Pomeroy

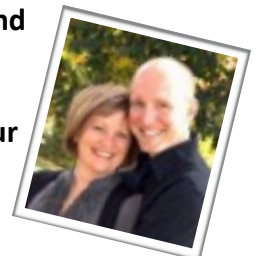
This time of year brings us out of the “relaxed” pace of summer vacations, back to school and the rhythm of busy schedules and routines.
